CBJ Assembly funds “PHASE 2” of COVID-19 Individual Assistance Grant program

On Thursday, February 11, the CBJ Assembly authorized [\\$700,000 in new funding](#) to help Juneau residents who experienced financial hardship due to COVID-19.

Catholic Community Service will administer the program and determine individuals eligible using applications received Dec 9-14, 2020.

“PHASE 2” of the program includes some changes to grant amounts per person and case processing. CCS is working to retool the program and will begin processing applications as soon as possible.

“PHASE 1” of COVID-19 Individual Assistance Grant program is closed

- \$2,000,000 in grant funds approved by CCS to be issued by CBJ
- 996 individuals determined eligible
- Average grant amount was \$2,008



Updated 12/30/20

All \$3 million in COVID-19 Housing Assistance funds have been issued to eligible applicants. This program is now concluded.

- Those who applied October 27 – November 18 have been notified by email whether they are eligible or not, and CBJ has issued all checks to households that were eligible for a grant.
- Due to the high demand for this program, there were not enough funds to provide grants to those who applied after November 18.
- Those who applied November 19 – December 12 will not receive a grant from this program.
